Treatment planning will be explored with the use of CBCT scan's in implant treatment planning software, mounted casts, and photo documentation. Participants will have an opportunity to convert a complete denture into a fixed immediate provisional.

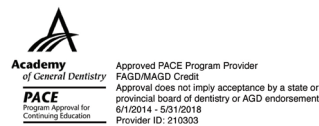
